

2. That on February 16, 2001, Lt. Joseph Kirby asked me to come into his office, and he showed me the pleadings that had been filed by the City Attorney asking for a protective order regarding the allegations made against Assistant Chief David Brame.

3. Lt. Kirby had highlighted the paragraph which indicated that Assistant Chief Brame had been accused of date rape by a woman fifteen months after the alleged incident. He told me that it was not a date rape, and was in fact a first degree rape with under threat of a weapon. He said it like it was fact, not a mere allegation. Lt. Kirby indicated that he was showing me this because he "wanted me to know what my boy was really like."

4. I asked Lt. Kirby why he was doing this, why was he bringing this up, and he said, "They are nickel and diming me, so I am going after them."
