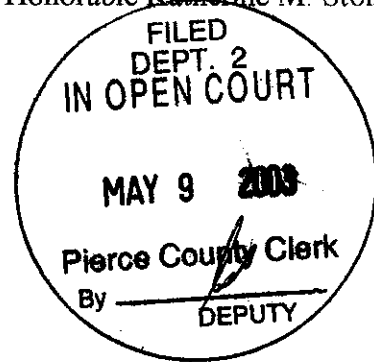


2 And having considered the record, it is therefore ORDERED that:

3 1. *The Seattle Post-Intelligencer*, *The Seattle Times*, The Associated Press, The
4 Washington Newspaper Publishers Association and The Washington Coalition for Open
5 Government are granted permission to intervene in this action for the limited purpose of seeking
6 to vacate the Protective Order entered in this action and unseal the pleadings and documents that
7 have been filed with the Court under seal pursuant to the Protective Order.

8 2. The Protective Order is vacated.

9 3. All pleadings and documents that have been filed with the Court under seal shall be
10 unsealed immediately by the Clerk of the Court. The Clerk is directed to allow *The Seattle Post-*
11 *Intelligencer*, *The Seattle Times*, The Associated Press, The Washington Newspaper Publishers
12 Association and the Washington Coalition for Open Government immediate access to all
13 pleadings and documents in the court file.

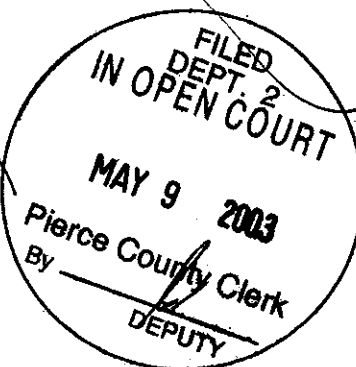
